Languages of instruction	Russian
Level of Russian language required for admission to courses taught in Russian	Russian BI (It is possible to get accepted with little or no previous knowledge of Russian language by combining Russian language classes in the morning with Master course studies in the evening)
Proof of language proficiency	The home institution is responsible for ensuring the required language level. Students must provide a written proof of their language skills.
