**Программа вступительного испытания по иностранному
(английскому) языку для поступающих на программу**

Moscow State University of Civil Engineering admits foreign citizens to the English Language Taught Degree program of the undergraduate level (Bachelor's Degree) on the competitive basis according to the evaluation of the applicant's personal portfolio.

1. Personal portfolio is evaluated according to the following criteria:

- GPA of the previous level of education, including the score in major subjects;
- achievements in educational and social activities, certificates, diplomas, etc.;
- certificate of proficiency in a foreign language;
- participation in competitions/olympiads (winner/prize-winner);
- recommendations (or other analogous documents) from the divisions of the MSUCE, colleges and universities of the countries of residence of the applicant, nongovernmental organizations, associations, Russian foreign missions, etc.;
- motivation letter (content and English language proficiency)

- Motivation Letter (Statement of Purpose) should be no longer than 2 pages of the text in the PDF format written in English language, and should include:
 - Education and practical experience (if any) of the candidate;
 - The purpose of study in bachelor's degree;
 - Your expectations of the program;
 - Professional plans for the future after graduation;
 - Other issues that you consider important.

We ask applicants to provide a motivation letter due to the high level of competition for admission to MSUCE. Thus, the quality of your motivation letter is an important criterion for admission.

2. Personal Portfolio will be graded on the 100 points scale, out of which:

- Documents. Maximum – 75 points;
- Motivation letter. Maximum – 25 points.
